Technology Leadership Certification

## Vision

Through the certification process, potential technology leaders master skills and knowledge to empower others to use technology to transform student learning through the Future Ready Framework.

At its core, building Future Ready Schools (Alliance for Excellent Education) is about transforming how schools educate students in the 21st century.

To accomplish personalized student learning, collaborative leadership must address seven driving gears:

- Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessment
- Use of Space and Time
- Robust Infrastructure
- Data and Privacy
- Community Partnerships
- Budget and Resources
- Personalized Professional Learning.

## Goals:

- Identify and select potential technology leaders who desire to pursue self-growth through a collaborative certification experience.
- Create technology leaders who are empowered to serve in a variety of roles in decision-making, professional learning, mentoring, and modeling of best practices.

## Expectation of participants:

- Attendance and participation
- Completion of monthly assignments utilizing best practices
- Development of a leadership implementation project

## Logistics:

- Four face-to-face days, plus one webinar
- Face-to-face days are planned in groups of two days that are three months apart
- Relevant assignments are completed during the months between face-to-face meetings

## Components:

- Three month commitment for a complete training experience of four face-to-face days, along with one webinar
- Individual and cohort team building; district level involvement
- Embedded training on technology integration for classroom and school/district level application
- Comprehensive dive into the Future Ready Framework and application at the school and district level
- Development of a leadership implementation project
- Best practices for transforming education through technology
- Consistent examination of the latest research in educational technology and implementation at the classroom and school level
- 30 PGP, based on full participation
