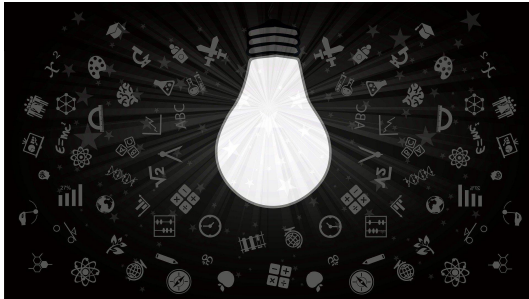


Planning Integrated STEM Learning Opportunities
